BP 3440 SERVICE ANIMALS

In order to prevent unlawful discrimination on the basis of disability, the District may allow an individual with a disability to use a service animal in District facilities and on District campuses in compliance with state and federal law.

The District adopts the U.S. Department of Justice definition of service animal, issued in its Final Rules amending Titles II and III of the Americans with Disabilities Act, dated September 15, 2010:

"Any dog that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability, including physical, sensory, psychiatric, intellectual, or other mental disability."

By this policy, the District adopts the definition of service animal adopted by the U.S. Department of Justice, as may be amended from time to time, within Titles II and III of the Americans with Disabilities Act.
